Making of the Old Basing and Lychpit Neighbourhood Plan (2015 - 2029)

As you are no doubt aware, the Old Basing and Lychpit Neighbourhood Plan was 'made' at Full Council on 19 July 2018. The Neighbourhood Plan forms part of the statutory development plan for the borough. Planning decisions in the parish of Old Basing and Lychpit will need to be made in accordance with both the Adopted Local Plan 2011 – 2029 and the Neighbourhood Plan, unless material considerations indicate otherwise.



The making of the Old Basing and Lychpit Neighbourhood Plan represents a major milestone in the development of the planning framework for the borough, and the council would like to thank interested parties for their contributions to the relevant plan making processes.

From the 19 July 2018, the Old Basing and Lychpit Neighbourhood Plan is subject to a 6 week period where applications can be made to the High Court on the grounds that the neighbourhood plan is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. This 6 week period of legal challenge ends on 30 August 2018.
