Notes of NPT Meeting on December 15, 2015

1 Feedback from Initial Contact with Stakeholders

Environment Agency had replied to AG, which stated the obvious and said our request was being considered.

It is not known if VR-S or Will Sarell had had replies from Post Office, HCC or Cycling Strategy. In the meantime

HCC had said they will come up with a solution on Crown Lane.

2 Evidence Logs & Policy Formulation

After the November 30 meeting, the consultants were refining the Landscape and Environment Objectives which

they expected to return week beginning December 21.
