1.	<b>APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE</b> Apologies were received from Cllr S Brown. Cllr K Tuck arrived at 7.05pm, at the beginning of item 6.
2.	<b>ELECTION OF VICE CHAIRMAN</b> The Chairman nominated Cllr A Renwick as Vice Chairman. Committee Members unanimously agreed to this motion. It was agreed that Cllr A Renwick shall be Vice Chairman of the Planning Response Sub-Committee.
3.	<b>CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES</b> The Minutes of the Planning Response Sub-Committee Meeting held on Tuesday 23 <sup>rd</sup> November 2021 were agreed as an accurate record of the events that took place with a minor amendment to item 1, to reflect that Cllr J Robinson had not formally sent his apologies as he had not received a summons to the meeting due to an administrative error. The actions recommended within the Minutes of the online Planning Response Sub-Committee Meeting held on Thursday 23 <sup>rd</sup> December 2021 were also agreed and ratified.
4.	<b>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST</b> No declarations of interest were received.
5.	<b>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION</b> No members of the public attended.
6.	<b>CHAIRMAN'S COMMUNICATIONS</b> <i>(Cllr K Tuck arrived at this point.)</i> <b>6.1</b> Following the meeting of the BDBC Economic, Housing and Planning Committee on 3 <sup>rd</sup> March 2022, Cllr D Whiter encouraged all members to review the Local Plan Update and the Draft Policy Framework which had been discussed at that meeting. In summary, the theme of the discussion was to find consistency and get the numbers right. Two new policies which will particularly affect Old Basing & Lychpit Parish Council are NP6 – River Loddon and NP7 – Local Green Spaces. <b>6.2</b> The Chairman confirmed that he and Cllr A Renwick will be meeting with West Waddy Archadia and members of SOLVE to progress work on the rebuttal document against the Local Plan Update. <b>6.3</b> Members of the Sub-Committee will be meeting with Mrs Maria Miller MP and Ward Councillors, to gain support for the Parish

**7. MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS**

**6.1 To receive *Briefing Note 4 – February 2022* and acknowledge any further progress made since the last Committee meeting.** Members observed that the briefing notes are useful.

**6.2 To approve the proposed 'Campaign' name of the working group aiming to address the Local Plan Update (ideally involving all local interested parties).** The Chairman clarified to those present that the campaign, although driven by the Parish Council, will incorporate other interested groups such as SOLVE, CPRE and Hampshire Wildlife Trust. Two name proposals were put forward to the meeting;

1. Conserve Basing & Lychpit ("CBL"), and
2. Basing And Lychpit Against Development ("BALAD").

Cllr J Robinson suggested that the name Old Basing & Lychpit Environment Campaign was more explicit.

Eight Councillors voted in favour of Old Basing & Lychpit Environment Campaign, one Councillor voted in favour of "BALAD" (no votes were made for "CBL"). The campaign shall be known as Old Basing & Lychpit Environment Campaign going forwards,

**6.3 To receive a report from Cllr A Renwick regarding current leaflet costs.** Cllr A Renwick explained to members that the design of the leaflet, intended to communicate the development threat to local residents, has cost more than anticipated. A total of seven hours of design work will now cost £336.00 (an additional £240 to the original quote). Since the additional cost related to 'Authors Corrections', Cllr A Renwick requested agreement to ask Greenhouse Graphics for an interim invoice for the design work undertaken to date.

Councillors unanimously voted in support of this action.

The leaflet production is currently on hold, waiting for confirmation of the proposed sites by BDBC. As soon as the sites are known, printing will go ahead with any adjustments made should any of the three sites not be included in the Regulation 18 document.
