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1.	APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE Apologies were received from CLr. S Brown, due to other commitments. CLr P Bloyce joined the meeting at 7.20pm.
2.	CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES The Minutes of the Planning Response Sub-Committee Meeting held on Tuesday 10 th May 2022 were agreed as an accurate record of the events that took place.
3.	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST No declarations of interest were received.
4.	PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION No members of the public attended the meeting.
5.	CHAIRMAN'S COMMUNICATIONS No communications were received.
6.	Update on Reports To receive an update on the rebuttal document being prepared for Old Basing & Lychpit Parish Council by West Waddy Archadia. The main rebuttal document is now written and subject to amendments where appropriate. The additional Landscape Report now incorporates Councillors comments and is considered complete, but CLr Tuck mentioned that the Portfolio Holder at Basingstoke & Deane Borough Council is also preparing a Landscape Report and that it would be worth waiting to incorporate any responses to that before agreeing to the Parish Council's version being finished.
7.	Land East of Basingstoke – Local Plan site SS3.9 To receive and agree a response to Hampshire County Council's consultants (Tibbalds Planning and Urban Design Ltd) following a workshop held on 12th July 2022 to work with the local community in developing its analysis and ideas about the Land East of Basingstoke site,

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which is allocated in the existing Local Plan for the development of new homes.

Cllr Renwick proposed that the Parish Council responded to Tibbalds questionnaire following the workshop held on 12th July 2022, answering as many questions as possible, although it was agreed that many of the questions were not possible to answer without further information being made available. Furthermore, he suggested that Councillor’s comments regarding the shortcomings of the workshop should be sent to Tibbalds for them to understand how much of a waste of time the Parish Council felt the meeting had been. It was agreed that the process had no credibility. Cllr Moore seconded the proposal and Councillors voted 8 in favour and 1 against sending the two responses.

Cllr Moore has additionally prepared a letter to send to the Basingstoke Gazette regarding the consultation and Councilors agreed that this should be sent with copies going to County Councillor Elaine Still, Tibbalds and the BDBC Planning Department.

8. OBLEC Website

To review the OBLEC Website design and contents.

The Chairman showed members some examples of the proposed website design for the OBLEC group; all agreed that the direction and style of the design was excellent. Cllr Renwick praised the designers and felt that the initial impact of the images shown was exactly right. A member of the public has provided the parish council with the photography of the area and the members agreed that credit for his work should be included on the website as his images enhance the website exponentially.

9. Campaign Preparation

To agree next steps for preparing the OBLEC campaign.

The Chairman suggested that the campaign will soon enter a crucial planning period. The next meeting will need to be longer to review the actions required with the whole campaign group.
