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| | <p>The start date for resurfacing the Crown Lane/Church Lane footpath was expected to be in August.</p> <p>Reinforcement of the footpath from Bartons Mill along the River Loddon will take place once Environment Agency consent has been obtained.</p> <p>The Chairman suggested bringing forward discussion of item 12.1 to enable Cllr Still to comment and he reminded members of the Planning Committee’s decision and timescales relating to the Milkingpen Lane Yellow Lines. He advised that he had also spoken to Borough Councillor Sven Godesen who indicated that changes within HCC Highways had caused the delays and that funds would not now be available for this project for another year. Cllr Still confirmed that she fully supported the project and the work going ahead as soon as possible following public consultation. Various views were expressed as to whether the yellow lines should be broken or continuous and the preference was that these should be continuous.</p> <p>The Chairman commented that the Parish Council was pleased to note the Crown/Church Lane Footpath was going ahead and also that work had finally started on the drainage works under the Milkingpen Lane Bridge. He thanked Cllr Still for her efforts on the Parish Council’s behalf.</p> | |
